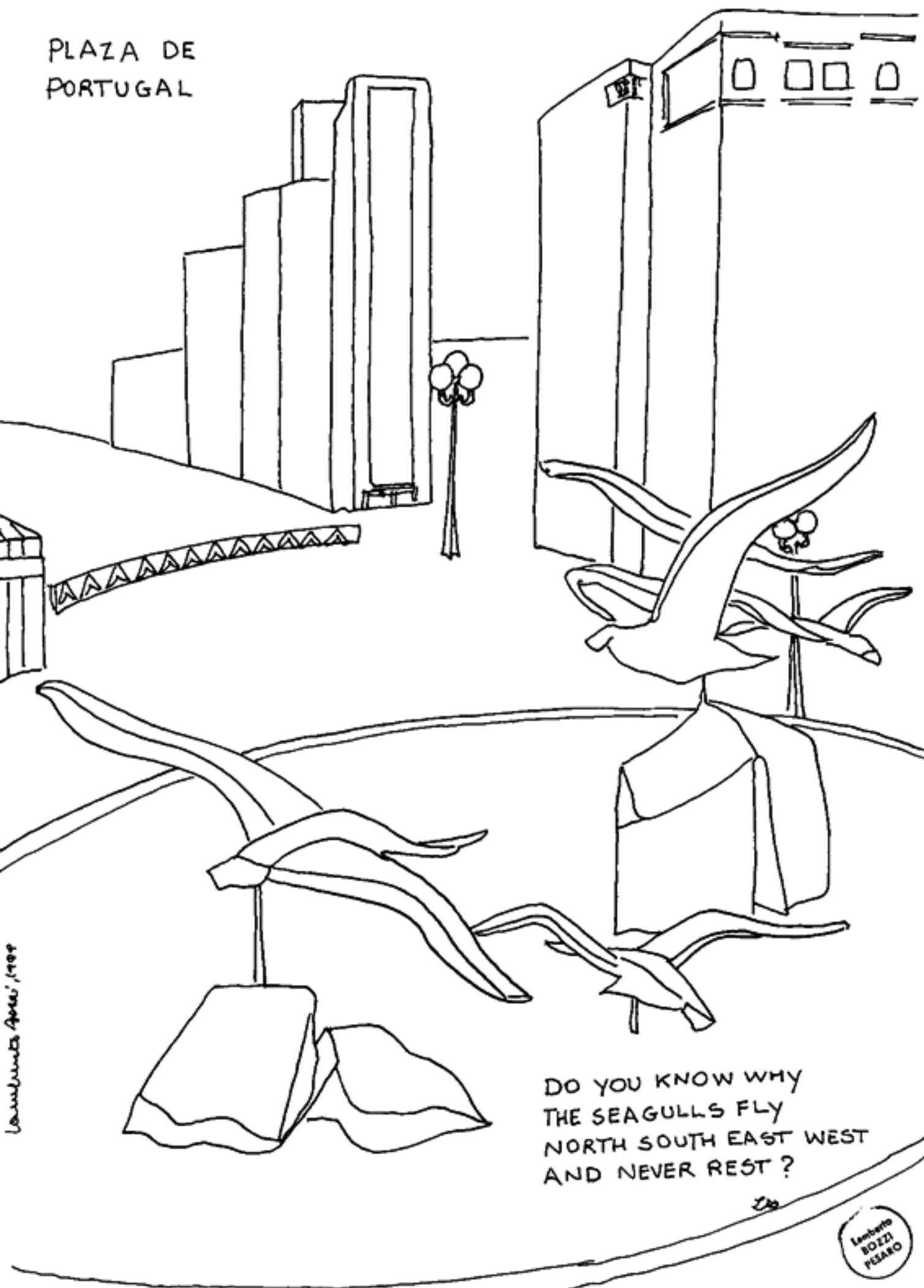


IT'S SUNDAY MORNING. PINOCHO IS

THE ADORATION OF THE MAGI.



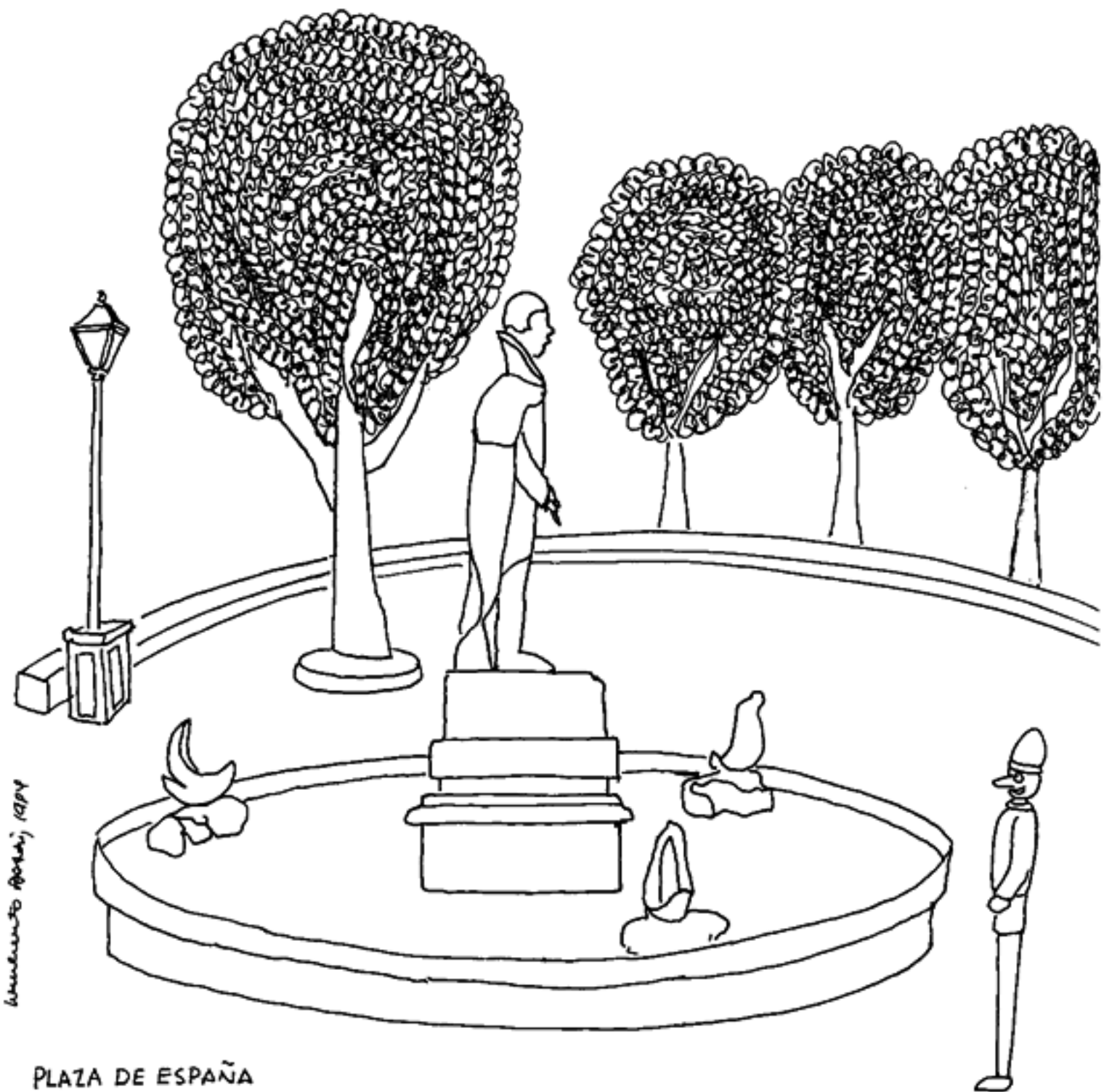

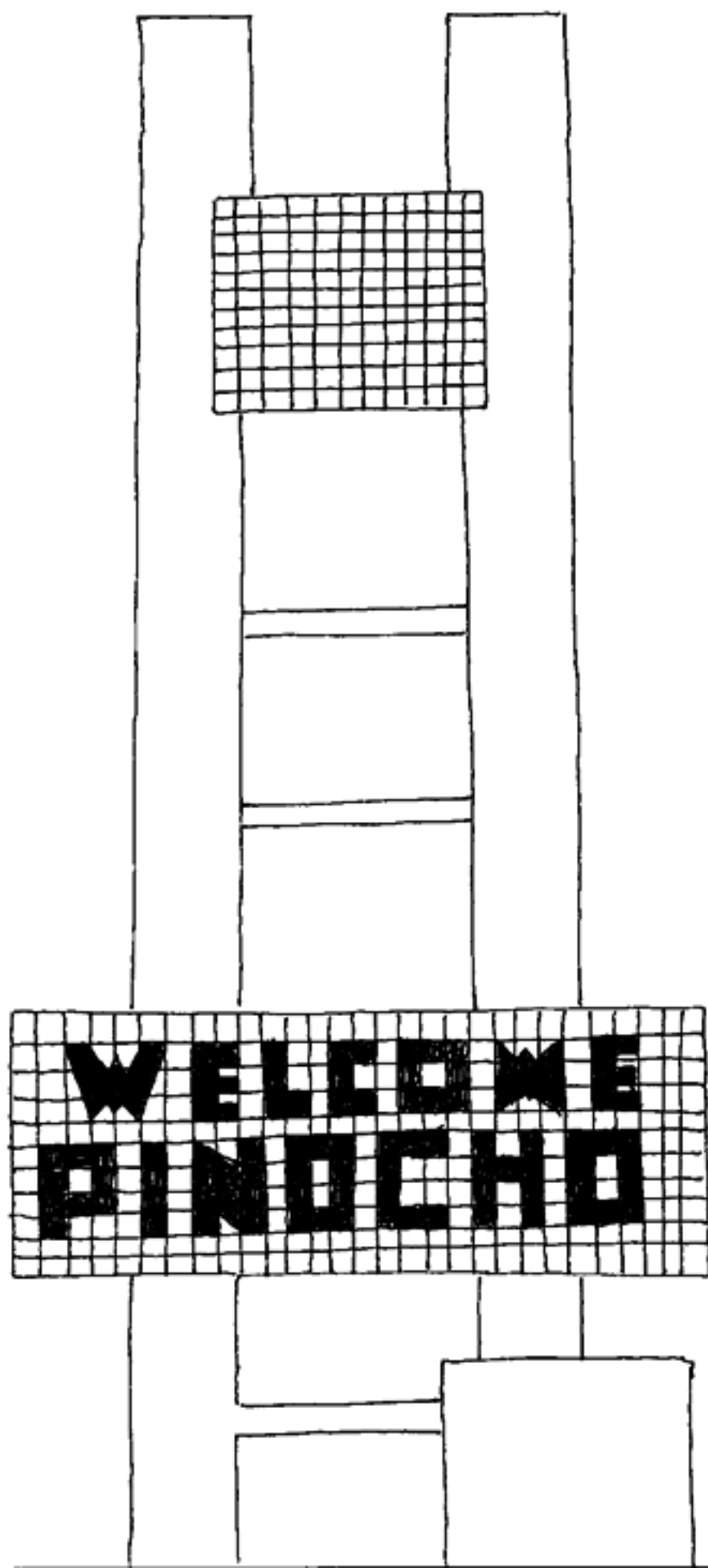
