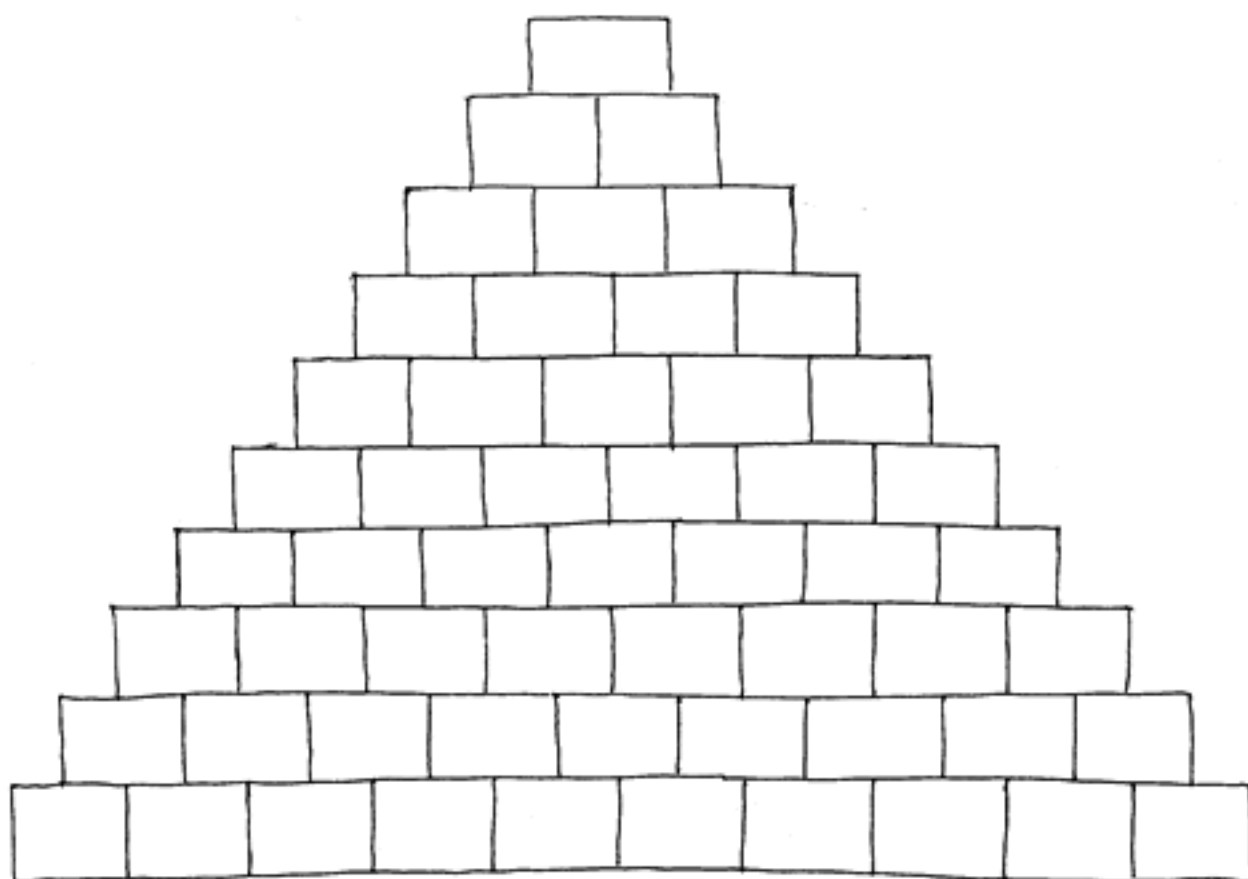

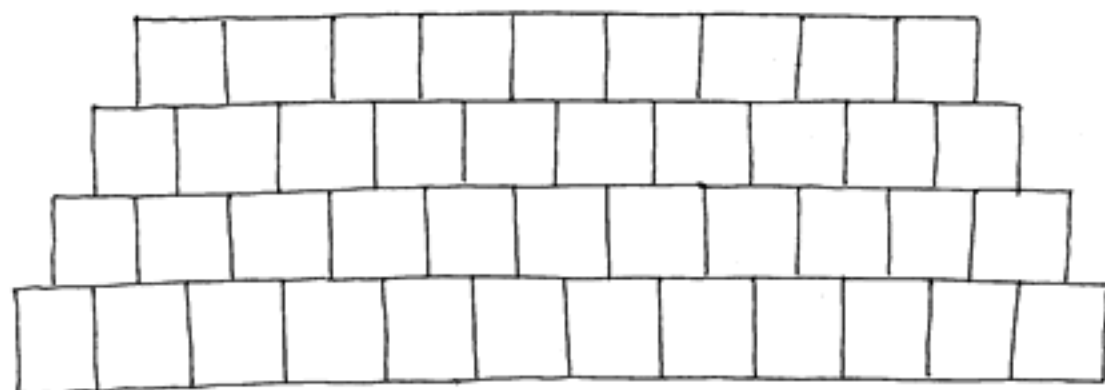

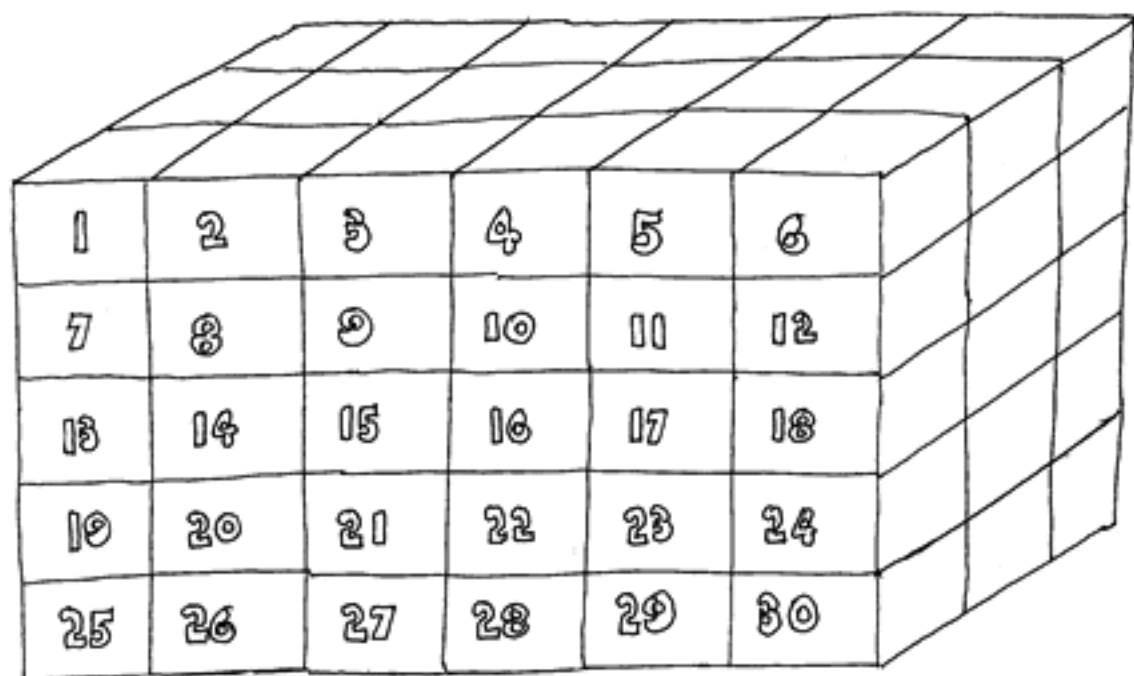
ONE BRICK ON TOP OF THE WALL
