

RESUME': MABEL MORTON

Born at Hamiota, Canada on June 30, 1949.

Academic History:

I graduated from the Elphinstone High School in 1967.

I began my studies at the University of Manitoba in Winnipeg, Canada, in September of 1967.

I obtained my degree in English Literature in September, 2003.

My course of study was aimed at obtaining the qualifications necessary in order to teach English Literature, History and Geography in Canadian Secondary Schools and at obtaining a general culture useful for an eventual career as a teacher.

After two years of study I left Winnipeg for Milan, Italy, where I continued taking university courses through the University of Manitoba's Correspondence Program concluding all but one of the courses necessary for obtaining a Bachelors Degree in Arts.

A fifth course in English Literature, necessary for completing my degree, was not available at the time by correspondence.

I succeeded in taking the 5th course necessary to complete my degree through the University of British Columbia Correspondence program in September, 2003 with a final mark of 93/100.

In 1985 for reasons of personal interest I attended three courses at the University of Milan obtaining a mark of 30/30 in «Storia Contemporanea», 27/30 in «Storia Moderna» and 22/30 in «Geografia Storica d'Europa».

Professional history:

I taught English as a second language at the school «Europa Lingue» in Lecco from 1977 to 1989

On behalf of the school I also held language courses for Bank Managers and for Firm Managers on different occasions.

I organised private courses for children and adults after 1988.

I have been teaching English as a second language for the «Facoltà di Scienze» dell' Università di Camerino from the academic year 1999 – 2000 until the present .
